Outreach

Joy Club - A Billingual Children's Outreach Program

Joy Club began in 2017 as a bilingual outreach activity program for children in LECC Aganai Church in Tokyo, held once a month on Saturday afternoons, teaching one Bible story and Bible song in English and Japanese. The children would deepen their learning through crafts and games which follow. The program was later held at a church member's home.

Joy Club had not been held for 3 years due to Covid but it started to meet again in October 2022. This time the meeting was held in a Japanese restaurant E.den, where Kouji Egawa, the husband of Joy Club teacher and MLP Media Consultant, Kaori Egawa, runs as the owner/chef. Kaori and her American co-teacher, Joseph Bandy, organized the event. Joseph, a member of Aganai Church, taught the story of Martin Luther. Kaori played the mini piano and sang a reformation hymn with the children. Kaori shared the translated Reformation story to Joeseph's Japanese wife as Joseph taught and sang a finger play song about Luther. For crafts, the group made fresh rosemary wreaths decorated with a Luther's Rose. The next Joy club meeting will be held in December 2022, Lord willing. Reformation Day

Martin Luther wanted everyone to know that we are forgiven through faith in Jesus alone, not through what we do. Luther learned this through reading the Bible. Luther wrote a letter telling what he had found in the Bible. It was a long letter with 95 different things he wanted to say.

On October 31st in 1517, he nailed the letter to the door of the church in Wittenberg, Germany. The next day was All Saints Day and everyone who went to church saw the letter on the door and learned the truth. Luther did many things to fix the church with his ideas. That is why we celebrate Reformation Day on October 31st every year.
